A pin system fastens this particular kind of platform onto your lift truck after sliding the platform on. The industrial hoist platform offers extra protection for the reason that they are outfitted with railings on three sides and a safety screen in the back. For added safety, it is a better idea to consider choosing a style which opens through the front railing instead of the side gate unit.

Stock pickers can attach onto a lift truck using the same mechanisms as other platforms but are much different. Stock pickers normally have a much smaller support surrounding by a front guard screen and railings on three sides.
